



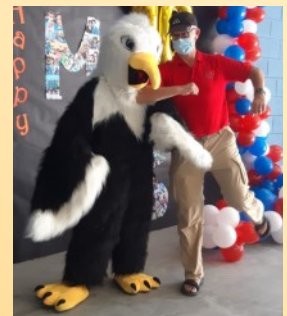

### \*Children's Day on the 11<sup>th</sup>

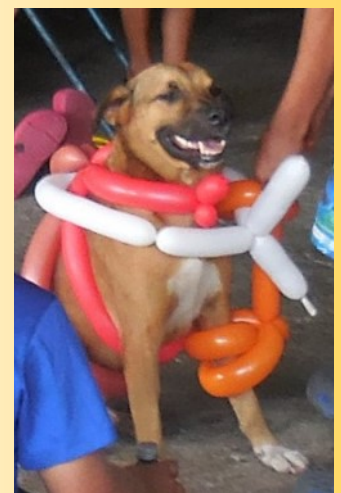
