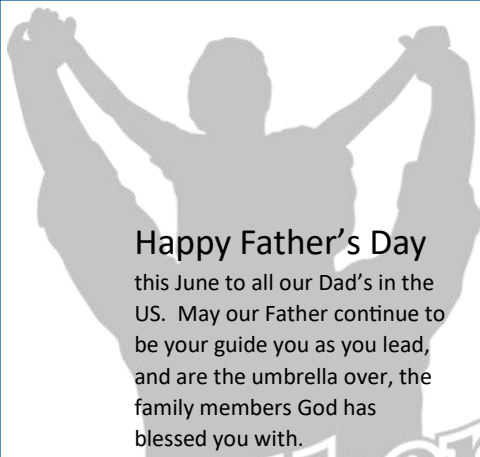

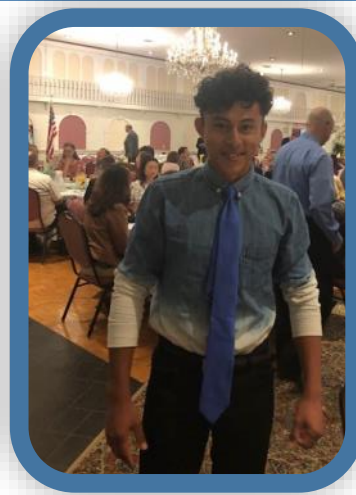

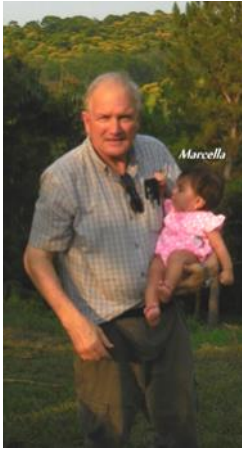
Recycling day

The cost to attend our school which includes tuition, books, uniforms, and insurance will be \$1800 for the 2019-20 school year (\$150 per month). Our beloved Mr. Steve, (Hauenstein, that is) has been here for a month spreading the love of Jesus and the love of science wherever he planted his feet. He not only does science at our schools when here, but goes to several other schools in the area to share science with them. Here is an excerpt from his recent weekly email home:



This week I spent with the little kids...kindergarten to 6th grade. One experiment I did to demonstrate water surface tension was great with kindergarten to second grade. Each kid had a plastic plate. I told them to get water from a wash tub, then set it on the concrete floor of the playground. I would sprinkle pepper on the water, then put a drop of liquid soap on their finger and when they touched the water the pepper would scatter to the outside of the plate. They had a great time playing with the water.

We had participants from first grade to eleventh grade at a spelling bee competition with 3 other private schools. H2H Family kids who participated are Marilyn, Nicol, Elena, and Estefany. We are so proud of our daughters and all our students. Well done!!
