



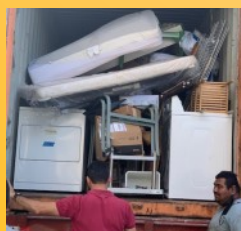

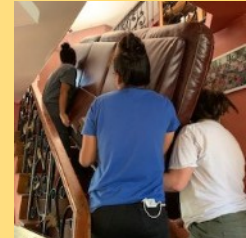

**Serrano house** – Our girls have done an amazing job of sorting all the clothing from the container, painting Marcel’s house, helping deliver food to the needy, and sorting/roasting/packaging coffee from our farm, to name just a few of the many things they do for our H2H family here.



**The Village** – We continue to do online school. I am at the village almost daily during the school week. Mayra and Iveth have moved in with the girls to help Katherine with the classroom for them. Nicolas is with Maria at the boys’ house helping there. Everyone is OK and blessed with good health.

**College in Honduras** – Our college kids are back at it for their next semester here. We have classes going online for them 7 days a week.

Marcel’s house is finished. He and Elvia have been helping in our ministry from the beginning. Their home was almost destroyed in the two hurricanes. Our boys and girls have finished rebuilding it and painting it, so it is like new. Thank you to everyone who helped make this possible with your generous donations to H2H for disaster relief.

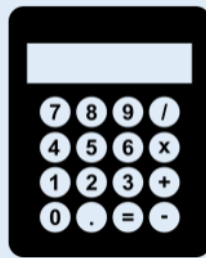

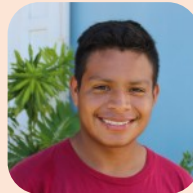
